

## Joseph El Hourany

Joseph El-Hourany is an architect (M.Arch 1999) and urban planner (MS 2005) who lives and works in Lebanon. He is also titular of two bachelors in philosophy (BA 2003) and musicology (BA 2007). From 2006 till 2010, he conducted a doctoral research at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in cotutelle with the University of Quebec in Montreal. In his doctoral thesis, he treated the architectural parametric principles in the age of cybernetics. Since 1999, Joseph is working on several architectural and urban planning projects in Lebanon and abroad; besides, he is teaching and lecturing in different research institutes and universities. He published “The Future Of The Past” with John Carswell in 2003, “Specimen Zero” in 2010, “Specimen One” in 2011, “Guvder” in 2012 and “Henri Edde architecte” in 2019. He participated in “Aley International Symposium of sculpture” (1999), and exhibited several versions of his “mind maps drawings” at LA CENTRALE (2007, 2008 - Montreal), UQAM (2008 – Montreal), Museum St-Hilaire (2008 – Quebec), Stata Center (2009 – Boston) and ALBA (2011).
